The Pangea Foundation has the project to build a park in the city of Alexandria.

The mentioned park will be a meeting place, for the approaching amongst people, cultural activity and reflection.

It will consist of a small semi-spherical hall, a multi-use building, a gate, a fountain and a commemorative monolith.



Why in Alexandria?

This is thanks to its historical significance as a place where the peoples of the Mediterranean came together and brought about a synthesis of cultures.

The Pangea Foundation has already started building a park in Toledo and by creating a similar park in Alexandria it wants to reflect this bond of union and reinforce it through joint intercultural activities.


The Pangea Foundation is an international, cultural, non-profit making organization.



The Parks throughout the world

In early 2004 the Foundation Pangea launched the project to build Parks around the world. This ongoing project has been evolving in breadth and scope.

Five Regional Parks will be built, one in each of the following locations: North America (in California), South America (near Buenos Aires, Argentina, already built), Europe (in Attigliano, Italy), Africa and Middle East (Alexandria, Egypt) and Asia (near Mumbai, India).

In most cases, the Parks will be part of a larger complex that encompasses the semi-spherical hall, a stainless steel monolith dated at its inauguration, a multi-use building, a fountain, and a stella engraved with the names of those who made donations.

The following National Parks are also being contemplated: Punta de Vacas, (Mendoza, Argentina), Manantiales (near Santiago, Chile, already built) and Toledo (Spain).

The Parks are usually located in the outskirts of metropolitan areas and close to major road intersections.

The parks are meant to be open areas where one can stroll, where there are various areas to meet and interchange, areas for meditation, and in some cases, with areas that serve for retreats and study.

Each Park is initially financed through a fund-raising campaign. The moneys collected are then administered by a Pangea Foundation which purchases the land, builds and maintains the complex in all its aspects including the legal ones.
